

National Place Pool Rules 2023

Pool Hours: 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM, 7 days a week during the summer months

1. All people using the pool do so at their own risk. National Place is not responsible for accidents, injury, or loss.
2. Children age 13 and under may not swim without a parent or guardian present.
3. Non-resident guests need to be accompanied by a National Place resident during the entire stay.
4. Each National Place household is allowed a maximum of 5 guests per visit to the pool. If there is a need to exceed this number, you will need to schedule a party. (See details below) Your visitors are expected to follow the same rules as the residents.
5. To avoid damage and a possible costly pump repair (remember your association dues), please hose off yourself and/or your children before entering the pool after playing in the sand or on the play set.
6. No playing on or with the pool rope or buoys, lifeguard safety equipment, or pool maintenance equipment.
7. No running or excessive play.
8. No glass, water balloons, or clear/transparent plastic cups are allowed in the pool area.
9. No cigarettes, vaping, marijuana products or tobacco are to be used in the pool area.
10. If you have a cold, cough, infection, or open wound; please stay out of the pool.
11. Scuba equipment, large inflatable rafts or things used in lakes or rivers are strictly prohibited. Use of rafts, balls or other large pool items may be restricted during peak pool usage.
12. No loud music in the pool or pavilion areas.
13. No food or drink is allowed INSIDE of the pool while you are swimming or wading in the pool. Please keep all food and drink on the tables to ensure the pool water stays clean.
14. Please use common courtesy and common sense when visiting the pool.
15. The Pool Manager and/or board members have the right to request that any guest leave the pool area if they do not follow the above rules or the general rules of the National Place subdivision.

Additional information regarding the pool

Fobs:

In order to visit the pool, you must have your pool fob with you to access the gate. All National Place residents who have paid their annual association dues have at least one active pool fob that allows them into the pool area. If your fob is not working or if you need additional fobs, fill out the fob request form on our neighborhood website, NationalPlace.org, under "Neighbor Resources." Please allow a minimum of one week for replacement.

General rules for fobs:

1. Each household may have one fob at no cost.
2. Lost/stolen fobs may be replaced at \$25 for the first time.
3. Any subsequent fobs may be replaced for \$50.

Pool Parties & Pavilion Rental:

National Place residents may request the pool, pavilion, or both for special events for themselves and up to 40 guests. Please note, the pool and playground area will still be open to residents during this time. Please fill out the form on our neighborhood website, NationalPlace.org, under "Neighbor Resources" to request your dates. You can check the google calendar on the website to see available dates. Dates are available first-come, first-served.

General rules for pool parties/pavilion rental:

1. No water balloons in the pool area.
2. Children must wash off sand and grass before returning to the pool area. Use the hose behind the building.
3. Pavilion area is to be hosed off, all food & trash picked up from grass areas and around tables ... including inside the pool at tables. All balloons/ribbons/signs must be cut down.
4. All guests must abide by the pool rules.
5. Fees: A cleaning deposit of \$50 should be given to the pool manager and will be returned when the party is clean and complete. Checks are to be made out to NPPOA.
